Chapter 10

Prayer

God speaks to us through His written Word. We speak to Him through prayer.

Jesus is the only link between earth and heaven. So we pray to the Father in Jesus' name. Not *to* Jesus, but *through* Jesus – to the Father. It is because we have accepted Jesus that the Father hears us.

When we pray, exactly what does that mean? What is prayer? "Prayer is the opening of the heart to God as to a friend" (*Steps to Jesus*, p. 92). And God *is* your Friend. If you need something, you can ask Him for it. If you are having trouble, you can tell Him about it. God is interested in you and in everything that happens to you. "He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all – how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things" (Romans 8:32)? If God gave us His Son, won't He give us the other blessings we need as well? (Read John 15:16.)

Sohodizin

Diyin éí Bizaad bee ak'e'ashchínígíí yee nihił halne' łeh. Nihí sodiilzingo Diyin God bich'i' yádeiilti'.

Jesus beego nahasdzáán dóó yá'aashii bee bóhólníihii bił haz'áanii bił ahił k'é náhásdlíí'. Áko Jesus bízhi' bee aTaa' bich'i' sozdoolziił. Jesus t'áá bí bich'i'go éí dooda; Jesus beego – aTaa' bich'i'. Jesus joodláago biniinaa aTaa' hwíísts'áá' lá.

Diné ła' sozdilzingo, haa lá yiit'iih? Áádóó sodizin wolyéii, ha'át'íí át'é? "Sodizinígíí éí hajéí Diyin God bich'i' aa ájíl'iigo át'é, ak'is nilíinii bich'i'gi át'éego" (Steps to Jesus, p. 92). T'áá aaníí Diyin éí hak'is nilíi lá. T'áá ha'át'íhída bídin jíliigoda Diyin bíjókeedgo há bíighah. Ti'hojooníihgo shíí, bíni'dii Diyin bee bil hojilne' doo. Diyin éí ni dóó t'áá altso áníléhígíí yíneedlí. "Diyin God t'áá bí biYe' doo ánéísiidgóó t'áá áníiltso nihá ninéidiní'á, da' doósh éí t'áá bil t'áá altsoní t'áá jíík'e nihaa yiiníil da doo" (Romans 8:32)? Azhá biYe' nidi niheiníltínígíí biniinaa, doósh Diyin éí t'áá altsoní bídeíníikeedígíí nihaididoo'áal da? (John 15:16 yínílta'.)

There are many blessings God wants to give us, but He waits to give them until we ask. We can have these blessings if we do ask, but not if we don't. The Bible says: "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will he opened to you" (Matthew 7:7).

When you ask for something, don't give up. Tell God just what you feel you need and ask Him to give it to you. But remember that He knows more than you do. "We cannot see the future, and sometimes we ask for things that would not be a blessing. Our heavenly Father in love answers our prayers by giving us what is best for us. He gives us what we would ask for if we could see all things as they really are" (*Steps to Jesus*, p. 96).

"We are to hold to God's promises even when it seems that our prayers are not answered. At the right time we will receive the blessing we need most. Ha'át'íhída bííníkeedgo shíí, t'áadoo t'áá' kónít'éhí. Díida, éida bídin nishlí nínízingo aTaa' bee bil hólne', dóó shaa dííléél bidiní. Áko nidi Diyin éí nilááh át'éego bil ééhózinígíí béénílniih. "Nihí éí la'ídi nida'ayiilzííh, dóó doo íiyisí nihil éédahózin da biniinaa, lahda shíí t'áadoo le'é doo nihá yá'át'éhígíí bídayíníikeed leh. ATaa' éí ayóó'ánihó'níigo biniinaa nihá yá'ádaat'éhígíí t'éí nihaa yiilé. Áko Diyin nihaa yiiléii, t'áá íídáá' daniidzin doo nít'éé', t'áá bí nahalingo dahoniidzáago t'áá altsoji' nihil éédahózin ládáá' " (Steps to Jesus, p. 96).

"Diyin éí bich'i sozdilzingo, doo shíists'áa' da jinízin shíí daats'í. Áko bíni'dii Bizaad yee ánínígíí t'ah nidi jóta' doo. Nihíists'áá' lá, áko baa hoolzhiizhgo índa aláahgo bídin daniidlínígíí nihaa doolyééł. Nidi t'áá áłahji t'áá hó jinínígi

that a prayer will be answered in just the way we desire. God does not make mistakes. He is so good that He will not keep from us anything that would help us. Do not be afraid to trust Him, even though you may not see an answer at once" (*Steps to Jesus*, p. 96).

Satan will try to keep you from praying, but pray anyway. Jesus is our Example and He spent much time in prayer – sometimes the whole night. By praying He received strength from His Father, and so can we.

It is good to pray in groups, such as the family or the church. But we should also pray alone. There are some things that need to stay just between you and God. Pray every morning and every night. At other times, like when you're working, you can also keep your heart lifted to God in

Séítan éí Diyin bich'į' sohodizinígíí yijoołá dóó bá bohónéedzą́ago t'ą́á' nóta' doo, doo sodílzin da doo biniyé. Áko bíni'dii t'ah nidi Diyin God bich'į' sodílzin! Jesus éí Bik'ehgo Áda'diilníiłii nilį́igo nízaadgóó sodoolzin – łahda díkwíí tł'éé' bíighah nidi sodoolzin lá. Azhá Jesus nidi biTaa' yich'į' sodilzingo bee bidziil nádleeh nít'éé'. Nihí ałdó' t'áá ákódadii'nííł.

Ahił sodazdilzingo éí yá'át'ééh – t'ááłá'í hooghandóó áłah dzizlíi'go, éí doodago sodizin bá hooghandi oodlání t'áá ałtso áłah daazlíi'goda. Nidi t'áá sáhí ałdó' sozdidoolziił. Jó ha'át'íhída diné náánáła'jígo doo bídéet'i' da łeh, ni dóó niDiyin God t'éiyá. Áko t'áá sáhí sozdilzin dooleeł – abínígo dóó e'e'aahgo, t'áá ákwíí jí. Áádóó shá bíighah sodizin k'ehgo Diyin God baa nitsídzíkees doo. Nitsizdéesgo'go sozdilzingo yá'át'ééh, nidi nijilnishgo hajéí biyi'di Diyin bił ałch'i'

prayer. "Silent prayers rise to God like smoke from sweet incense. Satan cannot overcome a person who keeps hold of God in prayer" (*Steps to Jesus*, p. 98).

We have talked about prayer as a way of getting the things we need – help, blessings, spiritual strength. But in our prayers we should also give thanks. A large part of our prayer time should be spent thanking God for things He has already given us. This is just as important as asking for what we need. Remember too that many of the things we take for granted are really blessings from God. We don't usually ask for these things (life, sunshine, air, friends, and so on), but God would be happy if we offered thanks for them.


Notice that our last three chapters have talked about things that should be a regular part of every Christian's life. These are: (1) helping others in whatever way we can (which includes telling them about Jesus); (2) studying God's Word (as well as thinking prayerfully about it afterwards); and (3) prayer (both asking for things and giving thanks). These are

Hanaagóó dahólóonii t'áá ałtso Diyin bee bééjílniih dooleeł, azhá doo shíí t'óó ahayóídi baa nitsínízdíkos da nidi. (Ááhdishnínígíí éí iiná, adinídíín, nílch'i, k'é hwiindzin, dóó náánála' ákódaat'éhígíí.) Diné la' kót'éego baa ahééshnízingo Diyin God bił yá'át'ééh lá.

Táa'go wólta'ii ałkéé' yíníłta'áa éí oodlání ts'ídá bik'ehgo nijigháa dooleeł. Díí ááhdeiłní: (1) T'áá bízhneel'áaji' diné náánáłahji' bíká aníjílwo'. (Díí éí t'áá háiida Jesus bee bił hojilne'ígíí bóólta'go óolyé.) (2) Diyin Bizaad jółta'go bínáhojiił'ááh. (Ałdó' jííłta'ígíí biyi'dóó sodizin k'ehgo hazhó'ó baa nitsídzíkees.) (3) Sozdilzin. (Ha'át'íhída Diyin bíjókeed dóó baa ahééshnízin.) Díí táa'go ałkéé' haz'ánígíí

not good works that earn salvation; instead they are ways in which Jesus comes close to us. If you are helping, studying, and praying regularly, then you will also be growing as a Christian. Jesus will recreate you as a new person in His likeness and your life will be a blessing – both to you and to those around you.
